

Typing the 'e' or 'schwa' in Wamba Wamba words.

The 'ə' appears in quite a number of Wamba Wamba words like 'katən' (water), 'manyə' (hand or five), 'kurrək' (country). It is a neutral sound like the 'e' in 'the' or the 'n't' in 'can't'.

Here is a handy keyboard shortcut if you have the right keyboard (ABC Extended or US Extended). Type - OPTION + : + a (or A if you want a Θ).

If this shortcut doesn't work with your keyboard you can add one of the two keyboards above in your settings or preferences.

If you are using a smartphone or tablet, the screen keyboards often don't include the schwa 'ə'. Find out if it does by checking holding down the 'e' and seeing if a 'ə' is included in the pop up list to select.

On both computers and smartphones you can set up a 'text substition' in preferences. You can designate a keyboard combination that you would use in either Wamba Wamba or English eg 'qe' (the schwa looks like a queer or strange upside down e). When you type 'qe' a popdown presents the 'ə' to select.
